- One home learning should last approximately 20- 30 minutes in Years
   7, 8 and 9. All students should be given at least two nights to complete a home learning task.
- If a subject has more than one home learning slot per week, then this
  may be combined into one longer home learning task (approximately
  40-60mins). Extra time will be given to allow completion of this
  extended task, usually an extra two nights.
- Modern Foreign Languages may give shorter tasks of approximately 10 minutes over three nights.
- Drama will set home learning once or twice per half term/module.
- Music will set a practical or preparation home learning twice or three times per half term/module.
- There is no expectation that extra holiday learning will be set in Years 7, 8 and 9.
