- The lesson codes appear on the student timetable e.g. Option A etc.
- One home learning should last approximately 30- 40 minutes in Years 10 and 11. All students should be given at least two nights to complete a home learning task.
- If a subject has more than one home learning slot per week, then this may be combined into one longer home learning task.
- GCSE PE will usually only receive one home learning a week from the theory lesson.
- PSHE/ Citizenship/ RE (non-GCSE) / PE will not receive any home learning.
