MUSIC TUITION

We currently provide tuition on;

Strings: Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass

Woodwind: Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone, Recorder, Oboe, Bassoon

Brass: Trumpet, Trombone, Horn(s), Tuba

<u>Percussion:</u> Piano, Keyboard, Tuned Percussion, Drum Kit Guitar (acoustic and electric), Bass Guitar and Singing (vocals).

Music tuition for Sept 2021 is £270 a year. (This is around £8 a lesson, which is very good value).

If you would like your child to **start** or **continue** Music tuition at Thornden School for the next academic year (Sept 2021) please;

- 1. Fill in the 'Music Tuition Form', sign and return.
- 2. Please read the 'Music Tuition Policy', sign and return copy 2 and keep copy 1 for your records.
- 3. Please send in 1 cheque for £90 we can also accept cash, the payments for the Spring and Summer terms will be available to you online once your child has been set up with an online account, this will happen from September 2021. Please note that by signing the policy and returning it to school with the first instalment you are committing to paying for music lessons for the whole academic year.

We now require parents/carers to enrol and send in payment to secure lessons for next academic year. This is so we can book the correct number of teaching hours and meet our financial agreement with Hampshire Music Service, the employer of our peripatetic teachers.

<u>Please return the enrolment form, signed Policy and first instalment to Mrs Laird in the Thornden Hall Box Office by Wednesday 24 March 2021. Lessons cannot commence in September if we do not receive this information.</u>
