

The School Age Immunisation Service records shows over 10% of Year 9 pupils have not had their MMR vaccine. You can still make an appointment through your GP.



Measles is a highly contagious viral illness that was common in childhood but is now rare due to the MMR vaccination programme. The MMR vaccine is the safest and most effective way to protect anyone against measles, mumps and rubella. Over 99% of those who have 2 doses of the MMR will be protected against measles and rubella.
