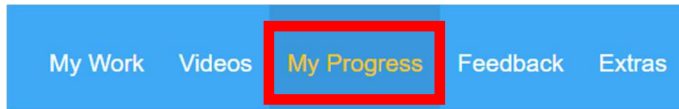



## How to use “My Progress” to further develop your Maths skills

Aside from completing your Maths homework tasks that have been set by your teacher, you can practise and extend your learning by completing extra tasks in the “My Progress” area of your Mathswatch account.

From the top tabs, click on “My Progress”:



You can then use the drop-down menu to select your **Qualification** (KS3 for Years 7-9, or GCSE for Years 10-11). Then use the **Topic** drop-down to select a particular topic you would like to practise. *For the GCSE qualification, you are also able to select a **Tier** of entry (Foundation/Higher) and even search by **Grade** before selecting a topic.*

Once you have chosen a topic, a list of videos will come up, allowing you to choose a skill to consolidate. Click on the one you'd like to practise and a video clip will load. You can watch the video clip first if needing a 'refresher' or skip straight to some practice questions by clicking on “Interactive Questions” (yellow button).
